

The Governor's Initiative on Lawyers
Assisting Warriors (GI LAW) helps meet
the legal needs of our Florida service
members when military attorneys cannot
due to federal law. Civil issues can range
from landlord-tenant issues and
consumer finance to family law.





Governor Ron DeSantis

Governor Ron DeSantis' vision to create the GI LAW program stems from his military service as a Navy Judge Advocate General. He saw how Florida active duty men and women were in need of legal assistance outside military channels. Through this initiative, our state's service members can receive the local counsel they need.



HOW IT WORKS

Service members requiring legal assistance apply for GI LAW through their base legal office. A military attorney then submits the legal services request to the GI LAW program.

Program staff review the request. If accepted, the matter is forwarded to GI LAW participating law firms for individual firm reviews and conflict checks.
