Kelsie participates in all phases of litigation from the early case assessment phase through trial. She coordinates the initial review of cases by drafting chronologies and identifying key themes, theories and witnesses to assist attorneys' with an evaluation of the matter. Kelsie also drafts answers, removal pleadings and routine initial dispositive motions. Throughout the discovery process, she assists attorneys by drafting requests and responses, managing the production of responsive documents, and evaluating the sufficiency of responses from opposing parties to prepare meet-and-confer letters and motions to compel. Kelsie also assists in factual investigations by locating witnesses, interviewing clients, employees and third-party witnesses and conducting public record searches. She has participated in trials throughout the United States in matters involving claims of property damage, single-plaintiff personal injury matters as well as multi-plaintiff claims associated with

exposure to toxic chemicals that allegedly caused personal injury and required medical monitoring. In preparation for trial, Kelsie assists by preparing motions in limine, jury instructions, witness and exhibit lists as well as coordinates with experts and vendors regarding demonstrative exhibits, technology and other logistical needs. At trial, Kelsie assists with jury selection and attends trial to coordinate witnesses, manage exhibits, and provide input and research as requested by trial counsel. Kelsie also assists after trial by polling jury members, drafting memoranda of costs or assisting with post-trial motions and appellate briefs.

Kelsie is passionate about ensuring projects run smoothly from the initial planning phase through the execution phase. She is analytical, communicates well and is a natural problem solver. She is highly involved in Shook activities, including as a staff diversity ambassador and a member of Shook's Toastmaster International public-speaking and leadership club, Shook Masters.
